The author declares,

1. that they are in full possession of the copyright and the associated exploitation rights for the submitted contribution,

This also applies to the correct identification of all textual and figurative quotations in the submitted contribution.

In the case of publication in the proceedings or treatises, the author shall transfer the exploitation rights arising from copyright to the Leibniz-Sozietät exclusively, without limitation as to time or place, but limited to exploitations made under the name of the Leibniz-Sozietät. The Leibniz Sozietät shall be entitled to conclude publishing agreements in its own name and to transfer the exploitation rights in this context. The transfer of rights shall not give rise to any claims for remuneration on the part of the author against the Leibniz-Sozietät or a publisher. One year after the publication of the contribution in the printed version, the author is also permitted to exploit it against payment or free of charge. Independently of this, advance publication on our homepage is permitted.

In the case of a publication in b) or the *Sitzungsberichte*, it is an open access publication. Everyone has the possibility to read, download, save and distribute the article non-commercially without changing it (BY-NC-ND). The exploitation rights remain unrestricted with the author. He or she may publish his or her contribution elsewhere at any time, but the Leibniz-Sozietät will then ask for a reference to the first publication on our homepage.

The author declares his agreement with the conditions set out here by his signature.
